Tuition Packets

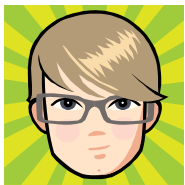

In this packet you will receive the cover letter, a tuition contract, a registration form and the service hour policy. When registering please note that if you have a student in going into Pre-K or Kindergarten next year you will fill out a **Yellow** registration card. Students entering grades 1 – 8 will fill out a **Blue** registration card. Along with your registration card you must send in **\$75.00 by March 5th**. After this date registration will go to **\$150.00**. Tuition for Pre-school next year has not yet been set. It will be available by March 7th at Open House.
